Executive Producer of
UPN's "HAUNTED"

Keith Addis is executive producer of UPN's new supernatural drama HAUNTED and co-founder of Industry Entertainment, which produces the series in association with Viacom Productions and CBS Productions.

Addis currently serves as an executive consultant on CBS's hit series "Becker." Additionally, Addis executive produced "Inherit the Wind," which earned a Golden Globe Award for Jack Lemmon, Emmy Award nominations for Lemmon and Beau Bridges, a Screen Actors Guild Awards nomination for George C. Scott and a Director's Guild nomination for Daniel Petrie.

Addis has also produced a variety of films, including "The New Age," "Fifteen Minutes" and "Antitrust."

Addis began his career working as an agent in the talent department of International Creative Management. In 1976, after working as an assistant to director Martin Scorsese on "Taxi Driver," he continued his agency career at the Robert Littman/Keith Addis Company, whose clients included actors Mia Farrow, Gene Wilder, and Alan Bates; directors Ken Russell and Nicholas Roeg; and writers James Dickey and Christopher Isherwood.

Since 1998, Addis has been serving as Chairman of the American Oceans Campaign, an environmental advocacy organization founded by Ted Danson in 1987.

Addis is a graduate of Columbia University.
