Ira Steven Behr is executive producer of UPN's 21st century version of THE TWILIGHT ZONE

Behr studied under Edward Albee at Lehman College and was offered a playwriting scholarship to Brandeis University. Instead, he elected to move to the West Coast to pursue a career in film and television.

Although his passion was for comedy, it was his work in drama where Behr made his mark, writing for such shows as "Fame" (for which he won the prestigious Scott Newman Award), "The Bronx Zoo" and "Star Trek: The Next Generation." His success on "The Next Generation" led to Behr being brought on-board as executive producer of "Star Trek: Deep Space Nine." He remained with that program for its full seven-year run.

Behr's most recent credits include "Bob Patterson" and "Dark Angel."

In addition to his television work, Behr is also the author of two best-selling books, "The Ferengi Rules of Acquisition" and "Legends of the Ferengi," which are both based on the comical Ferengi characters from "Star Trek: Deep Space Nine" series.

Behr is married with two children and lives in Los Angeles.
