Mark Stern is a partner and the president of television of Trilogy Entertainment Group. He brings his extensive production experience on more than 300 hours of television to bear in the execution of UPN's 21st century version of THE TWILIGHT ZONE.

After graduating from Dartmouth College, Stern moved to Los Angeles to work as a literary agent's assistant. He joined Trilogy in July 1987, and has served as director of development, senior vice president, executive vice president and president of production. Since 1999, Stern has served as Trilogy's president of television.

In 1993, Stern produced Trilogy's first television movie "Lifepod." Written by Trilogy partner Pen Densham, the film was an homage to the Hitchcock classic "Lifeboat" set in outer space. Stern also produced the pilot "Taking Liberty."

Stern supervised the development and production of seven seasons of the award-winning science fiction anthology series "The Outer Limits" and four seasons of "Poltergeist: The Legacy." He also served as an executive producer on "The Magnificent Seven," "The Outer Limits," "Houdini" and "Peter Benchley's Creature."

Stern is also an executive producer of the new series "Breaking News" and an executive producer on the upcoming three hour mini-series "Carrie."

Stern is married with two children and lives in Los Angeles.
